Courses: Sheep (3 head) and Cattle (3 head) Course D (Left Hand Pen) & Ducks (5 head) Course B

Sunday Arena Trials: Trial I – Ducks with Dana Mackenzie – Cattle & Sheep with Rachel Vest

Trial II – Ducks with Rachel Vest – Cattle & Sheep with Dana Mackenzie

Courses: Sheep (3 head) and Cattle (3 head) Course G (Left Hand Pen) & Ducks (5 head) Course B

Both days: Trial I Ducks and Cattle will run concurrently.

Trial II begins immediately following Trial I duck runs.

ENTRY INFORMATION

Pre-entries open on **04/12/19** and close on 05/03/19 by **postmark**. **No overnight, phone, or email entries.**

Entries will not be accepted without payment. \$35 charge for returned checks.

Arena Trial Fees: Ducks - \$35.00, Sheep - \$45.00, Cattle - \$55.00, Junior/Novice - \$20.00 per class

Trial site opens at 7 AM. Handlers' meeting at 8 AM each day.

Day-of entries will be taken from 7:00AM until 7:30AM each day if space is available.

Additional \$5.00 per class for same day entries (if available).

POLICIES:

- This trial shall be run under all ASCA rules and regulations. See [asca.org](http://www.asca.org) for current rules.

- Non-ASCA registered dogs – To have ASCA qualifying legs tracked and receive ASCA titling certificates, each non-ASCA registered dog will be required to have an ASCA Tracking Number. This is a one-time fee of \$10 per dog. At the time of application for the tracking number, the individual owner must also be an ASCA member (minimum membership type, the Service membership, is required). - Each individual is responsible for any damage caused by himself, his family or his dog while in the trial arena or on the trial grounds. Livestock replacement costs are as follows: Ducks - \$75.00, Sheep - \$350.00, Cattle - \$1,200.00. ASCA, WAV, and Keepstone Farm assume no responsibility for any accident or injury.
- Substitutions allowed per ASCA Stockdog rules.
- Bitches in season will run in order. They should be crated away from trial arenas when not competing.
- All dogs must be on leash when not competing. Please clean up after your dog.
- Entry confirmation will be sent by email. Please include your email address.
- Trial committee will draw run order prior to the trial.
- Entry fees will only be refunded if request is received before pre-entry closing date or if runs can be filled from a wait list.

AWARDS (including but not limited to):

Ribbons for all qualifying runs. Ribbons for 1st - 4th place, each stock, each trial.

Arena Trials: Rosettes for HIT Aussie, HIT Other Breed, HIT Started Aussie, and HIT Open Aussie.

Special Rosette for any dog WAV completing a WTCH.
